Thursday 8th July 2021

The new term starts:

Pre-School	Start back on Monday 13th September
Reception	Start back on Thursday 9th September (full days)
Yr1 –Y6	Starts back on Monday 6th September

- **Morning Drop off: 8.45-9am:** Parents are asked to bring their children to the main green gate in the morning (preschool to Y6). We are going to keep a staggered 'drop off' and staff will be ready to welcome your children from 8.45am (note the time change from 8.40am). Children in Class One will be greeted by their class teacher (Mrs Smith), and Miss Blewitt will be waiting to settle them into the classroom, helping them with hanging up belongings.
- **After school pick up: 3.00pm for Preschool**
3.10pm for Reception to Year 6

All children (preschool to Year 6) to be collected from the main green gates.

Building work- we will be having some building work to our front entrance, which will provide us with better access and a small indoor 'waiting area' for visitors. We hope that this will improve the welcoming feel of our school. There may however be delays to this and we anticipate that we may need to use the hall doors as our entrance to school for the first few weeks back. Please be prepared for this and we will give you email notice of this in the last week of the holidays. The same timings as above will apply.
