End of the day update.

 for wherever the children go from this point. This includes PTA meetings, fundraising events etc. We
 appreciate the continued support in ensuring the children's behaviour follows the values they are
 taught within school once in the community.
- If your child is being picked up by someone other than our known pickups please ensure you contact the school. We will ring you if we are ever unsure before allowing your child to go home.

Please be considerate when driving along the lane to ensure we keep all members of our community safe during pick up and drop off times. Staff will be monitoring the lane where they can. If there are any events of reckless driving please do contact the Police.
