



**English:**

As writers this term, we will explore the text 'The Journey'. From this, we will create an adjective poem with powerful adjectives. Later in the term, we will create our own narratives based on this text, and Year 3 will be adding dialogue to their writing. The next text we will look into is 'The Tin Forest' where we will create a setting description describing the Forest before and after.

**Guided reading:**

We will be developing our skills to decode and retrieve information from texts and develop our understanding to explain and interpret texts. Year 3 will be reading 'When the Giant Stirred' to link into our Voracious Volcanoes topic, following by 'Winter's child'. Year 2 will be reading 'Pop up Volcano', which also links to our Volcano topic, followed by the 'Three Little Pigs'.

**Music**

As musicians, we are learning to sing and use our voices to create and compose music. Before later learning a musical instrument!

**RE:**

As children of Bromesberrow, we will be exploring the faith of Islam by understanding how festivals and worship show what matters to Muslims. By being theologians, we will write our own stories to express the meaning behind something.

**Maths:**

As mathematicians, both year 2 and 3 are finishing off their addition and subtraction units. After this, year 2 will move onto exploring shape, whilst year 3 will broaden their knowledge on multiplication and division. All children will continue to learn their timestables within school too.

**Voracious Volcanoes!**

**PSHE (informed by British values):**

As caring members of our community, we will be starting our 'My Happy Mind' topic called 'Appreciate'. We will learn about what gratitude and appreciation is, and why they are so important.

**DT:** In design and technology this term, we are looking at electrical systems where we will evaluate a range of existing torches before designing a functional torch for a target audience.

**Art:** As artists, we will be focusing on teaching primary and secondary colours, colour mixing and creating textures using different tools. We will also discover techniques to create collages and encourage children to experiment with different materials.

**Physical Education:** As athletes, we will be learning skills in dance and football this term. As dancers, we will be able to move to a beat whilst travelling, stretching, twisting, jumping and skipping. In football, we will focus on playing competitively as a team and following rules.

**Geography:**

As Geographers this term, we are learning about volcanoes. We will look into why volcanoes explode and also the settlements around volcanoes, including extinct sites and understanding why people would choose to live there. We will also learn about what happens when an earthquake takes place.

**Computing:** As computer technicians, we are learning how to be safe online. We will understand what is safe to be shared online and what is not, including why we need passwords and that they cannot be shared. Children will know who to go to if they have any worries about anything online.

**Science:**

As scientists, our topic is 'Forces and Magnets'. We will investigate if all metals are magnetic, as well as understanding how friction works and comparing how objects move on different surfaces due to this. We will also observe how magnets attract and repel each other, and using this knowledge to group materials into magnetic and non-magnetic.
