



## Guided Reading Quality Text Planner

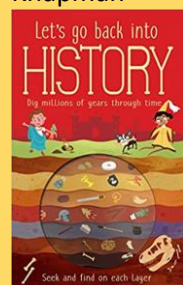
We use the DERIC Approach developed by Rhoda Wilson to plan and teach reading explicitly at Bromesbarrow. All of our texts are carefully chosen and planned in advance, from Early Years through to Year 6, to ensure that the children's reading diet is broad and balanced. The texts chosen and the level of questioning is progressive throughout the school, so that learning is cumulative.

DERIC	
	<p>Decode is where children use their phonics skills to work out unfamiliar words</p>
	<p>Explain questions will focus on explaining the meaning of keywords in the text.</p>
	<p>Retrieve questions are questions where the answer is clearly in the text and the children do not need to work anything out.</p>
	<p>Interpret questions require the children to unlock the meaning of the text from the clues given. Interpret questions will cover inference, summarising and predicting skills.</p>
	<p>Choice questions are always related to the choices that have been made by the author, illustrator, poet, director etc. and not the characters.</p>

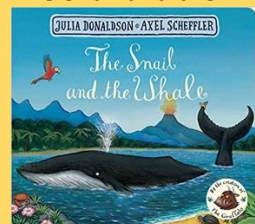
