As you know, we had our **SIAMS inspection** last Thursday. This was a positive and affirming experience, with the inspector gaining a deep understanding of our school and its unique community.

Thank you to everyone who sent in emails or took the time to speak with the inspector. Your support truly reflected the heart of our school. Both our children and staff shone brightly, and we are proud of what we achieved together.

#### **Before and Afterschool Care**

We are incredibly proud of our before and afterschool provision, which has been a vital resource for families and a joyful experience for the children. However, we must consider the long-term sustainability of this service. While we remain committed to ensuring no family is left without a provision, we are exploring innovative ways to enhance and secure its future.

One idea under consideration is to partner with the **Redmarley team** to create a combined before and after school club. This would involve bussing children across to the Redmarley site.

# **Positives:**

• Larger groups: Children will have more peers of their age group to connect with, fostering social growth and friendships.









- **Better planning:** With more staff and children, activities can be more tailored and engaging for different age groups.
- **Stronger collaboration:** Sharing staff across the two schools allows for greater flexibility and creativity in program delivery.

### **Challenges to Address:**

- Returning to Bromesberrow: We are exploring two options:
  - 1. A staff member, with business insurance and a roadworthy vehicle, could drive children back to Bromesberrow.for 6pm.
  - 2. Parents could collect their children directly from the Redmarley provision.

We value your input! If your family uses our afterschool care, we'd love to hear your thoughts on these options and any ideas you might have for improving the provision. Your feedback is crucial to helping us make the best decisions for our community.
