Baseline Assessment – Reception

If your child has joined us in Reception, they will be taking part in a little one to one assessment with their class teacher in the next few weeks. This is play based and very relaxed. It forms a baseline for the progress that they make with us. If you have any other questions please talk to Miss Oakes.

Special Education Needs

Just as a reminder, our school SENCO (the person who leads on additional needs and support) is Mrs Hankins. Children can have special needs at any time and may need support for a short or an extended period of time. Needs can range from anxiety and social difficulties to specific needs like Dyslexia. Please do get in touch with your child's teacher if you are concerned about your child's progress or needs in general.

Church Visit

Class 2 and Class 3 will be walking to the local church (St Mary's Bromesberrow) on Wednesday for a poetry workshop inspired by the church.

Governors

Class 3 children will be having first aid training this term as part of our PSHE curriculum, so hopefully they come home with some new skills!
